कबीर की प्रामाणिक रचना 'बीजक' है, जिसमें तीन भाग साखी, सबद और रमैनी। इनमें कुछ रचनाएँ गुरु ग्रंथ साहब में भी सकलित है।

कबीर निर्गुणी थे। उनका मानना था कि ईश्वर विश्व के कण-कण में विद्यमान है। उसे कहीं बाहर ढूंढ़ने की आवश्यकता नहीं है क्यों कि वह सदा हमारे साथ है। कबीर ने गुरु को परमात्मा से भी अधिक महत्व दिय़ा है। वे हिंदू-मुसलमानों में एकता स्थापित करना चाहते थे। इन्होंने जाति-पाति और वर्ग-भेद का विरोध किया।

कबीर की भाषा में अवधी, ब्रज, खड़ी बोली, फ़ारसी, अरबी पंजाबी आदि भाषाओं के शब्द मिलते हैं इसलिए इनकी भाषा को खिचडी भाशा भी कहते हैं।


